

# CITY OF GRANDE PRAIRIE COORDINATED CARE CAMPUS ADVISORY COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

#### Establishment:

The Coordinated Care Campus Advisory Committee was established to function as a Committee of Council and is guided by the Boards and Committees Bylaw C-1422.

## Purpose:

The purpose of the Coordinated Care Campus Advisory Committee (the "Committee") is to provide a link between the Coordinated Care Campus and the community. The Committee will provide advice and feedback on matters relating to the Coordinated Care Campus.

#### Mandate:

#### The Committee shall:

- provide advice and recommendations pertaining to community education, integration and engagement;
- provide advice and recommendations on identified matters of concern brought forward through the Good Neighbour Grievance process; and
- provide feedback in the ongoing evaluation and planning for the Coordinated Care Campus and its programs.

# Membership:

- 1. The committee will consist of a maximum of 9 members as follows:
  - Seven (7) public members
    - Four (4) community members / business owners;
    - One (1) member from Community Advisory Board on Housing and Homelessness;
    - o One (1) Indigenous representative;
    - One (1) health representative;
  - Two (2) City administration
    - o One (1) representative from Community Social Development
    - One (1) representative from the RCMP
  - Additional members may be called upon based on qualification and expertise on an adhoc basis



### Term:

As set out in the Boards and Committees Bylaw C-1422

## **Committee Operations:**

- The Committee will approve a regular schedule of meetings including a minimum of four (4) meetings held annually
- The Chair shall be elected from the Committee membership for a maximum term of two (2) years, unless appointed by Council

## **Performance Expectations:**

Members may leave the Committee by:

- Giving written notice a minimum of 30 days advance of the next meeting
- Being declared removed after missing three (3) consecutive meetings without valid cause
- Being declared removed by a 75% vote of the Committee quorum for reasonable cause (e.g., not embracing a collaborative approach or breach of confidentiality)

## Confidentiality:

 Advisory Committee members are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of all proprietary or privileged information they are privy to while serving as an Advisory Committee member.
