TIPS & SAFETY

- Always wear your reflective vest. You want to be seen out there looking out for your neighbourhood.
- Take water bottle, flashlight if at night
- Cell phone to report or for emergencies
- Tell someone where you are going, which route/quadrant and when you'll be back
- Be aware of your surroundings
- Listen to your instincts
- Walk facing traffic
- If no sidewalk, walk near the curb unless cars are parked in the street
- Stay away from shrubbery, dark areas and alleys
- Never assume parked cars are empty
- Avoid using headphones, you might not hear trouble approaching
- Be alert, look over your shoulder
- If you suspect you are being followed by a pedestrian:
 - Cross the street
 - Don't turn down an alley or dark side street
- If you suspect you are being followed by a vehicle
 - Turn and walk in the opposite direction
 - Get license number
 - Never try to outrun a vehicle, change direction whenever possible.
- Hand out Neighbourhood Eye cards to encourage neighbours to come out and join the walks
- Use the Know Your Neighbour Cards to get neighbours to meet one and other and exchange information
- Give out "You've been caught doing a good deed" cards to recognize positive actions by our neighbours
